WHAT IS HIV?

HIV is the Human Immunodeficiency Virus, It is virus that causes AIDS. Only Humans can set and transmit HIV. HIV is easily identified three month after time infection, by taking and HIV test.

WHAT IS AIDS?

By Sharing needles or syringes with an infected person.

From an infected mother to her child during pregnancy, childbirth, or breastfeeding.

By getting infected blood into your bloodstream.

(Please note that blood transfusion are safe in the USA)

Through casual contact

Through hugging or kissing

Through insect bites or animal contact

Through sharing your household with someone infected HIV
